Universal use for milling and feed



Advantages:

- Top 1 in yield potential and yield stability
- Medium maturity and good straw stability
- Big kernels, medium to high hectolitre weight
- Very high mildew tolerance

Cultivation:

Excellent quality for a variety with such yield potential
 For areas of Northwest-Europe
 Avoid sowing in areas of high altitude, due to delayed straw maturity

Short profile:

---- = very low resistance/early/short,

++++ = very high resistance/late/long
